GRADUATION READY

- ☐ Schedule an appointment with SAM Center to verify you are on-track to graduate.
- ☐ Apply to graduate. Application fee is \$50 before **January 28**; and is \$80 after.
- ☐ Ensure transfer credits are processed by the Office of the Registrar by **May 11** at noon.
- ☐ Monitor your graduation status through your DegreeWorks.
- ☐ Verify spelling of your full name in MySam and if needed, submit Name Change Request Form.
- ☐ Verify your Permanent Legal Address in MySam by **April 30** to ensure diploma is mailed correctly.
- ☐ Set reminder: Diplomas will be mailed to you about 8 weeks after commencement.

COMMENCEMENT READY

- ☐ Check the commencement schedule for your ceremony date and time.
- ☐ Reserve your eight Commencement guest tickets using your SAM ID starting March 2 at 10 AM. Graduates will be notified if additional guest tickets become available.
- ☐ Watch video on how to prepare for the ceremony.
- ☐ Order your cap and gown through Herff Jones by **April 9**.
- ☐ Watch video on how to wear your cap and gown.
- ☐ Invite family & friends to ceremony and share the live webcast link with those who can't come.
- ☐ Request commencement accommodations at least two weeks before your ceremony.
- ☐ On Commencement Day, arrive at the Recreational Sports Center (RSC) for check-in at least **one hour before** your scheduled ceremony with your cap and gown; purses and bags are not permitted. See Graduation Checklist & Student FAQ for more information.

RECORDS & ADMINISTRATION READY

- ☐ Resolve outstanding balances in full via MySam or Student Account Services.
- ☐ Complete Exit Counseling (if required). Contact our Financial Aid & Scholarships for assistance.
- ☐ Check your eligibility for the Tuition Rebate Program and apply (if eligible) by **May 8**.
- ☐ Request official transcript(s) for graduate school applications, job applications, etc.
- ☐ Take the First Destination Survey to share your post-graduation plans with SHSU.
